The goods and services specified in the bid documents are not proprietary and in cases where specific products and/or methods are named in the bid documents, the specifications clearly state "or equal" products will be considered if offered by the Contractor.

When the contract for this chemical was previously bid, only one bid was received by PVWC which bid was rejected and bids subsequently re-solicited for the contract. The goods and services specified in the bid documents are not proprietary and in cases where specific products and/or methods are named in the bid documents, the specifications clearly state "or equal" products will be considered if offered by the Contractor.

When the contract for this chemical was previously bid, notwithstanding solicitation of bids to numerous potential bidders, only one bid was received by PVWC which bid was subsequently awarded to Polydyne, Inc. (Polydyne) of Riceboro, Georgia at their unit bid price of \$2,070 per tote (at 270 gallons per tote).
