Summary

It is recommended that, under Project 15-P-51, Environmental Engineering and Technology, Inc. ("EE&T") of Newport News, Virginia be awarded an increase of \$35,000.00 (increasing the total previously approved not-to-exceed amount for Project 15-P-51 from \$50,000.00 to \$85,000.00) to provide PVWC with additional professional services related to the Project as set forth in the attached copy of EE&T's proposal dated March 4, 2016. These recommended additional professional services under this proposed Contract Amendment to Agreement for the Project are set forth in more detail below.

Background

Project 15-P-51 "Professional Engineering Services for Corrosion Control and Treatment" (the "Project") was awarded to Environmental Engineering and Technology, Inc. ("EE&T") of Newport News, Virginia at PVWC's Commission Meeting dated June 17, 2015 in accordance with the authorized scope of work, and with reimbursement to be on a time-and-materials basis, not to exceed \$50,000.00.

PVWC requires additional professional services to assist PVWC in its ongoing efforts related to lead and copper issues and other water quality issues.

At PVWC's request, EE&T has submitted a proposal dated March 4, 2016 (the "Proposal") to modify the Project to include the additional professional services related to the above, and which were not included under the Project.

A copy of the Proposal, including a breakdown of the scope and additional costs related thereto, is attached hereto (as an attachment to Exhibit B referenced below).

EE&T's Proposal for the additional professional services as set forth hereinabove has been reviewed and is reasonable, considering the nature and scope of additional professional services involved.

It is recommended that, under Project 15-P-51, EE&T be awarded an increase of \$35,000.00 thereby increasing the total previously approved not-to-exceed amount for Project 15-P-51 from \$50,000.00 to \$85,000.00 to provide PVWC with additional professional services related to the Project under the Contract Amendment as set forth in the attached copy of EE&T's proposal dated March 4, 2016.

Subject to concurrence and approval by the Law Department, the said changes will be incorporated into an Amendment to Agreement for the Project, the form of which is included in Exhibit B.
