



Construction of upgrades and improvements to Passaic Valley Water Commission Lead Service Line Replacement in Main System in the amount of \$37,605,981.00 were financed by the New Jersey Water Bank (NJWB). The NJWB is a State Revolving Fund program jointly administered by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (Infrastructure Bank) and uses a combination of funds provided by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the DEP, and the Infrastructure Bank to provide very low interest loans to borrowers for environmental infrastructure projects.

This project will provide water quality benefits by removing and replacing lead service lines in turn improving the water quality and safety for residents and businesses in the City of Clifton, City of Passaic and the Borough of Prospect Park, Passaic County.

State Revolving Fund programs around the nation provide states and communities the resources necessary to maintain and improve the infrastructure protecting our valuable water resources nationwide.
