

CHECK THE PLUMBING IN YOUR HOME

Not sure what type of plumbing is in your home?

Here's one way to make sure your family is safe.



Homes built before 1986 are more likely to have plumbing containing lead or lead solder. New homes may also have lead. Even brass faucets, fittings, and valves, including those advertised as "lead-free" may contain some lead.
