
Update: Passaic Valley Water Commission Issues Boil Water Advisory for sections of Clifton and Paterson

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

(Passaic County, N.J. – June 19, 2024) – Due to a water main break, Passaic Valley Water Commission (PVWC) has issued a boil water advisory for residents and businesses in Clifton and Paterson, specifically in these areas:

- Clifton/Paterson: Lakeview Ave from Maryland Ave to E 3rd St
- Clifton/Paterson: Marshall Street / Kuller Road
- Clifton: Route 46 (Piaget Ave)
- Paterson: 21st Ave going east to E 26th St

This advisory is effective immediately and will remain in place until further notice.

Immediate Actions Required:

- **Boil Water Before Use:** All water for drinking, cooking, making ice, brushing teeth, and washing dishes should be brought to a rolling boil for at least one minute. Allow the water to cool before using.
- **Alternative Water Sources:** Please use bottled water if boiling is not possible.

Reason for Advisory:

The advisory is a precautionary measure to ensure the health and safety of our community, our top priority.

Ongoing Efforts:

PVWC crews are actively working to address the issue and restore normal water service. We are conducting thorough testing and will provide updates as they become available.
